

WP 1- Project Management, incorporating roll modelling PAR process to incorporate overarching educational process for local partner contextualisation

#### Objectives

- O1.1 Ensure the progress of the project: Monitoring that the milestones are reached to the highest possible quality, and the tasks progress in line with the EEEFCom work plan.
- O1.2 Day to day project management: Including legal management and financial monitoring, and report this properly to the European Commission.
- O1.3 Planning and preparation of project meetings, steering group meetings, WP leader meetings, and quality control of deliverables.
- O1.4 Overall data management: Coordinating the collection, storage and exploitation of primary and secondary data used in EEEFCom, ensuring compliance with European and national data protection laws.
- O1.6 Establishment of an overarching participatory action research (PAR)process that incorporates, students, associate partners, partners and any other relevant stakeholders in the educational process and project outcomes

### WP2 - Development of the evaluation framework

#### Objectives

- O2.1 Establish proof of concept evaluation framework adopting Participatory Action Research methods, clearly illustrating the benefits of the emancipatory educational programmes implemented throughout the project life cycle.
- O2.2 Monitoring agreed outputs the framework will ensure all project partners position marginalised learners and excluded communities centrally in the co-creation and delivery of community based mental health and substance use programmes to meet locally identified needs across all programme sites within the timelines set.
- O2.3 Amalgamate data form across all learning sites. Findings will be presented in proof of concept report using Human Rights, Recovery Education and Community Development indicators
- O2.4 Proof of concept report disseminated, demonstrating programme feasibility and impact with a view to realising programme sustainability beyond the scope of the Erasmus+ funded project life cycle, embedding this community model of work within policy and practice to support individuals and communities marginalised because of mental health and substance use.

#### Description

- Evaluations of programmes delivered during the implementation phase of the project include all 'Recovery: Learning Together Training for Trainer' programmes and the subsequent sets of 'Mental Health Wellbeing Programmes,' designed and delivered by participating stakeholder groups across all programme sites.
- Open dialogue groups with local stakeholders across all programme sites will be carried out at the end of the implementation stage of the project. These dialogical spaces will offer participants the opportunity to critically reflect on learning processes collectively.
- Comprehensive whole project quantitative and qualitative measures will be completed by participants that took part in two or more participatory outputs over the course of the project life cycle including programming during the implementation phase, open dialogue meetings, transnational meetings and multiplier events.
